Mercy UK acknowledges and accepts that there are different expressions and Christian traditions within the Christian faith.

At Mercy UK, our theological approach is best described as liberationist, that is, we believe in the authority and the power of Jesus and the Word of God in seeing people live free and stay free.

We encourage participants to challenge, explore and develop theological viewpoints within the context of their own relationship with God.

As a Christian charity, we affirm that:

- The Bible is the accurate and authoritative Word of God and applicable to our everyday lives.
- There is one God, the Creator, who exists in three persons; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. He is totally loving and completely holy.
- Jesus Christ is the Son of God and the only one who can reconcile us to God. He lived a sinless life, died on the cross in our place and rose again to prove His victory and empower us for life.
- In order to receive forgiveness for our sins we must repent and believe in Jesus Christ who equips us to live a new life.
- God desires to heal and transform us so that we may live free, stay free and reach others more effectively.
- Our eternal destination is determined by our response to Jesus Christ and we believe He is coming back again.
- The Church is the body of Christian Believers, called into committed fellowship with one another and anointed to be the hands and feet of Jesus to the world.
